No.12/PMS Forms/2018-TA&H: The Department of Tribal Affairs & Hills,(Tribal Affairs Division), Manipur invites applications for award of **Pre Matric Scholarship(reading in Classes IX & X)** and **Post Matric Scholarship** from the eligible Scheduled Tribe students whose parents'/guardians' annual income does not exceeds Rs. 2,00,000/-, & Rs.2,50,000/- respectively in the Govt./Govt. recognised schools/intitutions in India for the Academic Session of 2018-2019.

[A] ISSUE OF FORMS :

Pre/Post Matric Scholarship application Forms can be downloaded (*to be printed on both sides of Legal size paper*) from the department website - www.tahmanipur.gov.in

[B] SUBMISSION OF FORMS :

The filled in application Forms should positively reach the office of the undersigned on or before **31st October, 2018**. Scholarship forms should be forwarded by the Principal/Head of institution along with detailed list of the students, Date of birth, Parents' names, Full address with District, Annual income, Aadhar no., class-wise with Roll No., Enrolment/Regd.no.& dt., Board/University names, **Bank Account No. with IFSC and MICR Codes & Contact Nos.(Phone)** of each student in **hard copy as well as soft copy in MS Excel** format, to the undersigned within the stipulated date. This office will not be held responsible for furnishing of wrong Bank account numbers and Codes. After this stipulated date of submission, no application Form will be received. It will be entirely the responsibility of the concerned school if their forwardations are not accepted due to late receipt at this end.

[C] NB (note well) :

- (i) All the institutions are required to submit an attested copy of affiliation order/letter & recognition letter of the institution as proof that the institution is affiliated to a Government recognised Board/University and that the institution is a Government recognised Institution.
- (ii) Each applicant should furnish his/her Bank Account details in the Annexure-I and II (formats prescribed by the Govt.) which may be downloaded from Govt. website mentioned above. A photostat copy of the first page portion of the Bank Pass Book, where account number, IFSC Code etc. are printed, should also be attached in the application Form.
- (iii) Since the Govt.of India has decided to implement the scheme through Direct Benefit Transfer(DBT) mode, it is notified for the awareness of all concerned and advice to furnish accurate details of the applicants which will be uploaded through National e-Scholarship Portal (NeSP) to digitized all the beneficiary's records incorporating with Aadhar Number.
